South Beach has a ton of green spaces to explore.

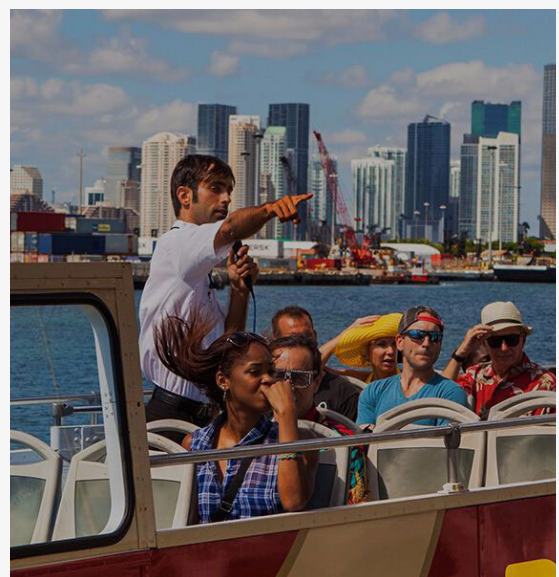
